Attachment One – Conditions of approval

1. Approval of this Construction Management Plan is limited to the elements listed in the Condition 31 of the City Decision Notice MCU/2023/471 dated 19 April 2024. Should any change to the conditions of the MCU development approval be made, additional or amended plans must be submitted for approval as necessary to comply with such conditions.
2. This approval is specific to the construction methodology only and does not approve any other management plans such as traffic, noise and dust management plans.
3. The approved construction management plan 'Construction Management Plan' dated 16 January 2024 must be complied with and kept on-site at all times.
4. A 'Temporary Road Closure and Works Zone Application' form and a complete Traffic Management Plan is required to be submitted to Council when a section of Council road reserve (including footpath area) is being interfered with for any building or construction related works. This includes occupation of the road reserve for any structure such as a gantry or hoarding. The online application form can be located at the 'Forms and applications' section of Council's webpage www.goldcoast.qld.gov.au
5. A 'Temporary Road Closure and Works Zone Application' form and a map identifying the required parking bays is required to be submitted to Council when a section of kerbside parking is being utilised for exclusive use for construction vehicles for any building or construction related works for a duration longer than four (4) weeks. Contact Council's Traffic Management section of telephone 07 5667 3639 for further information. The online application form can be located at the 'Forms and applications' section of Council's webpage www.goldcoast.qld.gov.au.
6. Applications for road closures on state-controlled roads must be lodged with the Department of Transport and Main Roads.
7. Use of a Council park or reserve requires approval from Council's Parks Gold Coast section on telephone 07 5581 6984.
8. Where an alternative haulage route exists that impacts less on the residents, the contractor is required to ensure that route is to be followed.
9. Working hours outside of 6.30am to 6.30pm Monday to Saturday are not approved as part of this application. Note that noise associated with construction related vehicles (including concrete trucks with their motors idling) arriving at sites prior to 6.30am is considered to be noise associated with building work and is therefore not permitted.
10. Where developers propose to alter standard construction hours, an application for a 'permit to carry out a regulated activity – building work noise/building site activity outside normal hours' is required.
